Women who are, or may be pregnant are potentially at risk of acquiring certain infectious diseases from pregnant livestock including sheep and goats. All our livestock comes from a flock / herd where no problems regarding the above have been recorded. As an extra precaution if you are pregnant it is strongly advised not to touch the sheep, lambs goats or goat kids. If you require any further advice please ask a senior member of staff for details.



Wash your hands please

Please remember to wash your hands thoroughly, and regularly, to stop the spread of bacteria. It is strongly advised that you wash your hands at the hand wash stations during your visit, before you eat, and before you leave the farm. Please also use the hand sanitizer on your way round the farm, which will act as a further defense from bacteria **but will not replace washing your hands properly with soap and water.**

## General Rules & Health and Safety

It is never possible to make any farm a totally risk-free environment. Our animals are well cared for but all animals (and the earth itself) naturally carry a range of micro-organisms, some of which can be transmitted to humans and may cause ill health.

Our animals are chosen for their calm and friendly temperaments but any animal can be unpredictable if it is frightened or teased, or even if it's having a bad day!

- Please make sure that children are supervised at all times. Children under 14 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
- Cover all existing cuts, wounds, or grazes with a waterproof plaster or dressing to avoid infection.
- Do not let children put their fingers in their mouths, or kiss any of the animals.
- Do not eat food on the farm except for in the designated areas, and please do not leave any litter.
- Anything dropped on the ground should not be used again until it has been properly disinfected; this is particularly the case with toys, comforters, and dummies.
- Wash your hands using the soap or hand sanitiser provided before eating or smoking and after handling animals. Please note: The farm is a no smoking area.
- Please step through the disinfectant puddles located around the farm as you enter and leave, to avoid bringing any germs into or out of the farm.

#### The E. coli Risk

Please Note: It is understood that E. coli is contracted through the faeces of certain prone animals, although all animals, including humans, have low levels of this in their systems. Humans touching contaminated areas i.e. fences or animals that have come into contact with it can contaminate themselves by simply touching their mouths. We attempt to contain the risk through the use of fencing and restricted access to animals. Areas of risk are regularly sprayed with an appropriate disinfectant. Animals that are petted or come into contact with humans are cleaned and disinfected to the best of our ability. **Following the Hand washing guidelines at our hand wash stations will greatly reduce the risk of E. coli.**


